# TOPIC: Approval of Purchase of Hydration Stations

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of 40 hydration stations for various buildings in the district from Ferguson Facilities Supply, Newport News, Virginia, for a total cost of \$61,776.

### RATIONALE:

This will help us meet the state requirements of the Filter First program, which requires schools and childcare centers to develop a drinking water management plan, including installing bottle filling stations (i.e. – hydration stations) that reduce lead levels in all drinking water fixtures.
