Background Information

Edgenuity is a computer-based learning platform which provides individualized academic content courses for students. Edgenuity includes content area specific lessons as well as test prep for STAAR/EOC, ACT, SAT, GED, and TSI for students in Grades 6-12. The program also includes MyPath, a grade level intervention instructional software for students in Grades 5-8. As a cloud based platform, Edgenuity can be accessed from many different devices and can be accessed by students from home, if desired. Implementation of Edgenuity began as a pilot in the spring of 2017 for credit recovery, STAAR test readiness, intervention, and virtual learning. The platform has been used successfully for the past 7 school years.

Duncanville ISD is proposing to renew a one-year contract for all high school and middle school campuses for an unlimited number of student users. If approved, implementation of Edgenuity will continue seamlessly into the 2025-2026 school year.

Recommendation

The District recommends the renewal of the proposed one-year contract to Edgenuity for Instructional Support Software in the amount of \$180,100.00 as presented. It is also recommended that the Board authorize the Superintendent to finalize the contract renewal with Edgenuity and to execute the contract on behalf of the district.
