Subject: Bonding Discussion and Timeline

Summary:

As the district is looking toward a potential bond election in November 2024 for the purpose of rebuilding Highland and West High Schools, and addressing other capital needs, this discussion will focus on the next steps in this process. We will cover the bonding process and a timeline of the necessary steps to hold a bond election in November. The timeline is attached. We will also discuss the possibility of having the architects that have been selected for these potential projects begin with preliminary work to be able to move the projects along as quickly as possible in the event a bond is passed this November. Please note that the architects for these potential projects were chosen through a procurement process when we did the feasibilities studies.

Scheduled to be at the meeting to discuss the process and answer any questions are Alex Buxton from Zions Public Finance, the district's financial advisor; Ryan Bjerke from Chapman and Cutler, the district's bond counsel, and Kyrene Gibb from Y2 Analytics.

Requested Board action:

We are seeking direction from the Board to put a bond election resolution on the agenda for the August 6th meeting. We are also seeking direction to put purchase orders on the August 6th agenda for the architects to begin preliminary design work for both Highland and West High Schools.
