Students in Mrs. Matthews class had 24 eggs delivered and had the opportunity to observe 16 eggs through an incubator as they watched 13 chickens hatch after 21 days. Mrs. King's class had 24 eggs delivered on April 10th and are in the process of observing these with anticipation of baby chicks. After the chickens are hatched from the egg, students are able to observe, hold, and care for them. The chicks are then placed with local farmers.
