6. 2026 Refunding Bond Resolution

Attached is a "parameters resolution" to seek the necessary approvals from the Department of Treasury and to authorize the prospective underwriter, Stifel, Nicolaus & Company, Inc, to "test" the municipal market to sell the school district's refunding bonds. The refunding bonds are for the purpose of refinancing the school district's outstanding 2016 School Building and Site and Refunding Bonds. 7. 2026 Building and Site Bond Sale, Series II Resolution

Attached is the 2026 Building and Site Bond Sale Resolution for the second phase of the \$117 million bonds that were approved by the voters in May 2024. This was also discussed at the October Board workshop. This second series of

8. Approval of GSRP Playground Equipment

The Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) has continued to grow over the past few years. Our current playground for ages 3–4 is no longer adequate for the 186 children enrolled in the program. The Kids First building has three playgrounds—one each for El Puente, TK, and Preschool (which includes both tuition-based and GSRP students). A map of the building and playground locations is included for your reference. If approved, some of the existing equipment in the TK/Preschool area will be relocated to other elementary buildings.

A preliminary plan and cost estimate are attached for your review. The total projected cost is approximately \$200,000. We have requested \$146,641 from the OAISD to be funded through the GSRP grant and are currently awaiting approval. The remaining cost would be covered by General Capital Projects as the District's matching contribution.
