# STUDENT VOICE & FEEDBACK

## COMMON CONCERNS

- **Elementary:** Verbal bullying, lack of trust in adults.
- **Secondary:** Social bullying, low school pride, and inclusivity struggles.

## PROPOSED SOLUTIONS

- **Enhanced supervision in high-traffic areas.**
- **Continue to utilize Student Handbook and Code of Conduct for consistent handling of incidents.**
- **Celebrating diversity and fostering inclusive friendships.**

# SCENARIO DISCUSSIONS

## **Elementary Example:**

- Logan bullying Cameron on the bus.
- Impacts: Fear, absenteeism, and isolation.
- Solutions: Increase bus monitoring and adult intervention

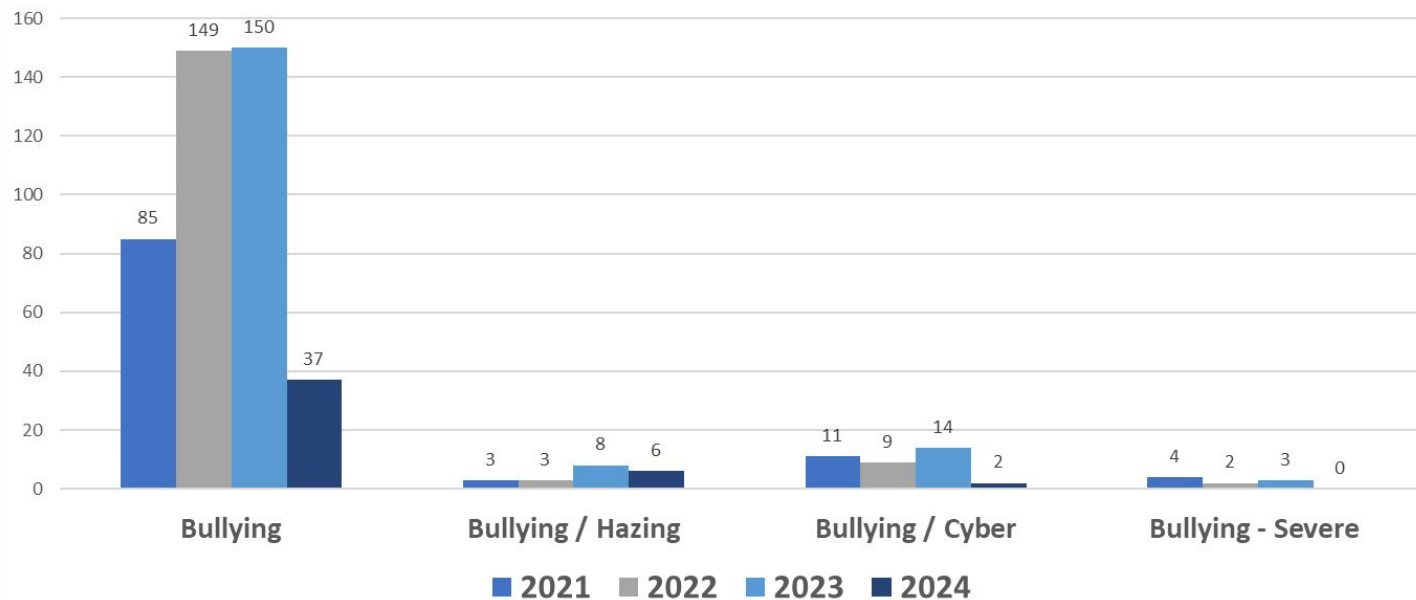
## **Secondary Example:**

- Social media bullying over a shared romantic interest.
- Impacts: Isolation, classroom conflicts.
- Solutions: Promote digital citizenship and peer accountability.
