

Windows 7 End of Life

- Microsoft will discontinue security updates for the Windows 7 Operating System on January 14, 2020
- The district had over 3,500 (out of 7,030) Windows 7 computers in January 2019.
- The district currently has 2,628 Windows 7 computers as April 1st.

Replacement of Financial Systems

- Consolidating Finance and Human Resources into a single system to improve efficiencies.
- System to go live on July 1st.
- New system will integrate with the Subfinder System and Student Management System
