SET Report for 1st quarter 10-11 Harlem Middle School

Total Offenses:

- Harlem Middle School had a total of 211 major referrals in the 1st quarter.
- Decrease of 69 referrals from 1st quarter of 09-10
- 110 students accounted for 211 referrals.
- 96% of the students have zero or one referral for the first quarter.
- Notable referrals were DIB, Dangerous behavior, INS and Inappropriate language (Student to Staff).

Total Race Report:

- For 1st quarter 10-11 18% of the student population was minority students.
- 17 students accounted for 30 referrals totaling 14% of all referrals.

Disaggregated Discipline Data Free and Reduced Lunch

- During the first quarter of 10-11 547 students were eligible to receive Free and reduced lunch (FRE).
- That is 47% of the 1149 students enrolled.
- 65% (137) referrals were generated by FRE students. (Decrease of 4%)
- 35% (74) referrals were students <u>not</u> receiving free or reduced lunch received one or more disciplinary referrals.

Disaggregated Discipline Data SpEd:

- During the first quarter 10-11 159 students were identified as receiving special education services.
- This is 14% of the student population.
- 30 students accounted for 66 referrals totaling 31% of all referrals.
- 24 of the 30 students who received referrals were eligible for free and Reduced Lunch

Totals Location Report:

- Classroom has 99 referrals.
- Hallway has 44 referrals.
- Bus has 22 referrals.

Totals Author report:

• Inappropriate language to staff accounted for 14 referrals. Decrease of 9 referrals.

Totals Action Report:

- 7 Incidents occurred 1st quarter this school year which led to 10 students being referred to juvenile authorities. Same as last year.
- 7 Eighth and 3 Seventh graders
- 8 male and 2 female students
- 8 Referrals were for Drug possession/Sale or Alcohol
