Thank you for the school's application to increase its enrollment cap, submitted to Osprey Wilds (OW) on March 17, 2025. This letter authorizes Crosslake Community School (CCS) to begin serving up to 700 students in Grades PreK-12, effective upon contract revision.

Expansions are evaluated and ultimately granted based on a charter school's demonstrated ability to fulfill the primary purpose of charter schools as described in MN Stat. §124E.01: "The primary purpose of charter schools is to improve the learning, achievement, and success of all students." OW understands that determining student success depends on many factors.
