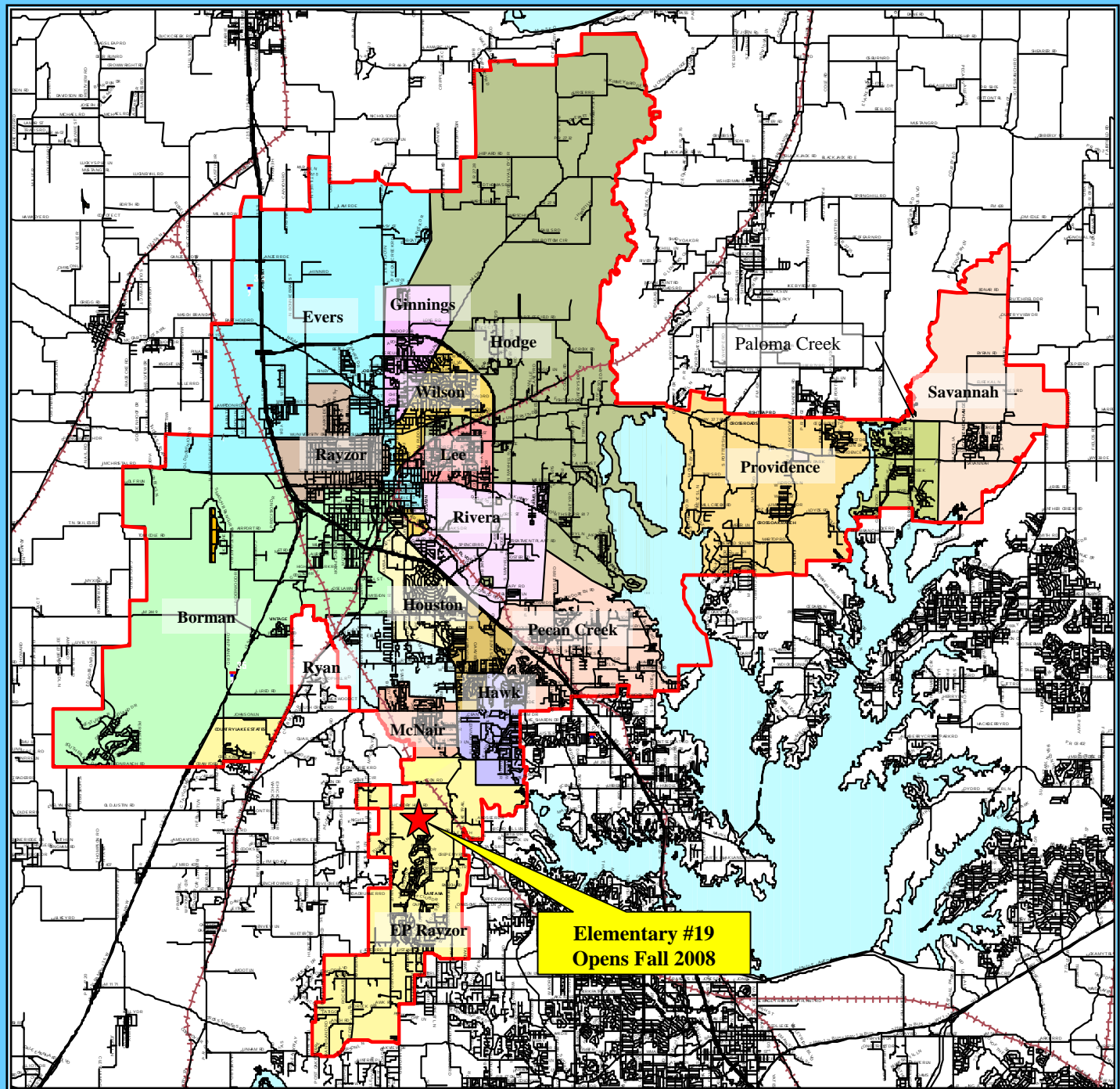

# Denton ISD 2007-08 Elementary Attendance Zones

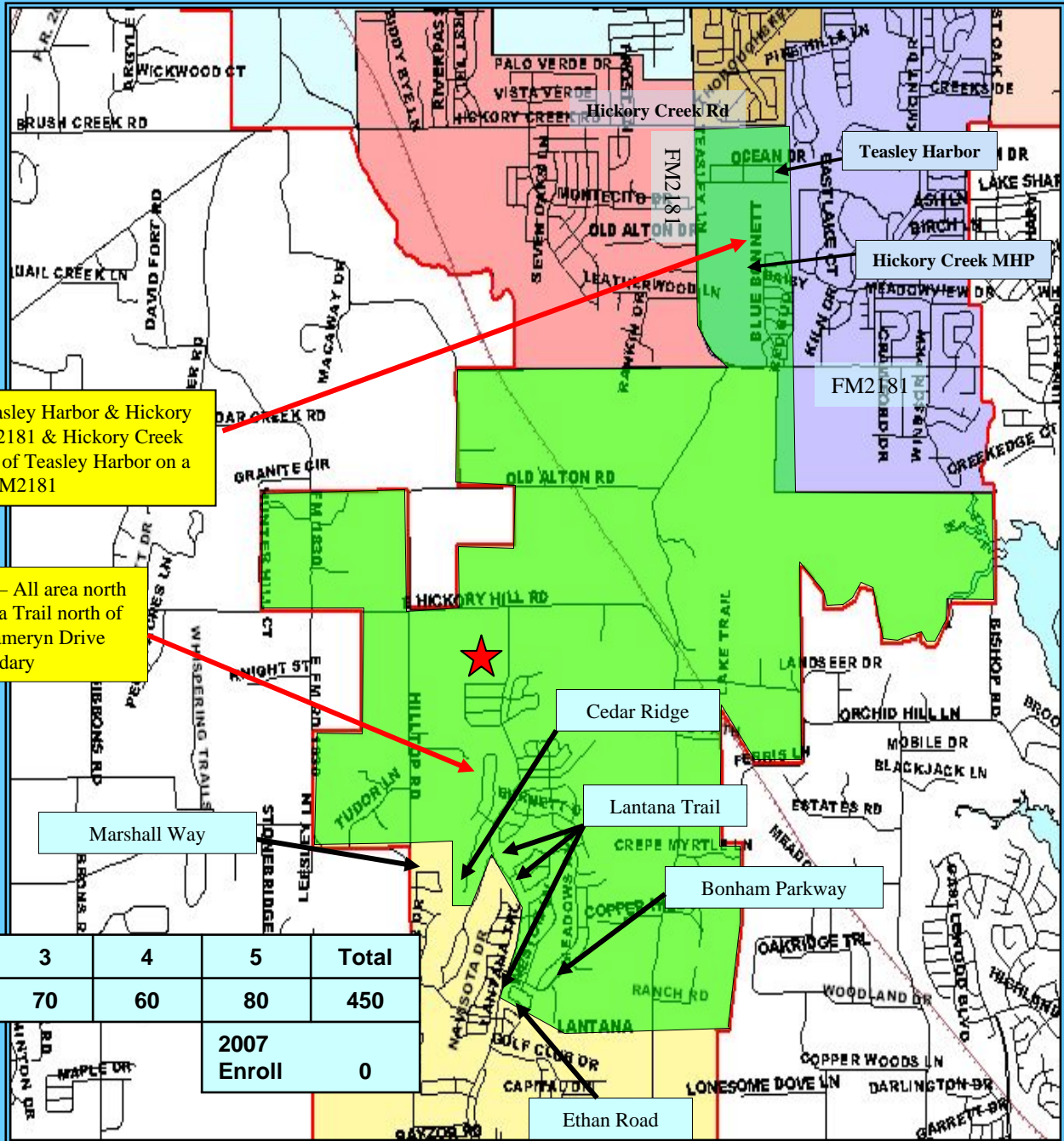

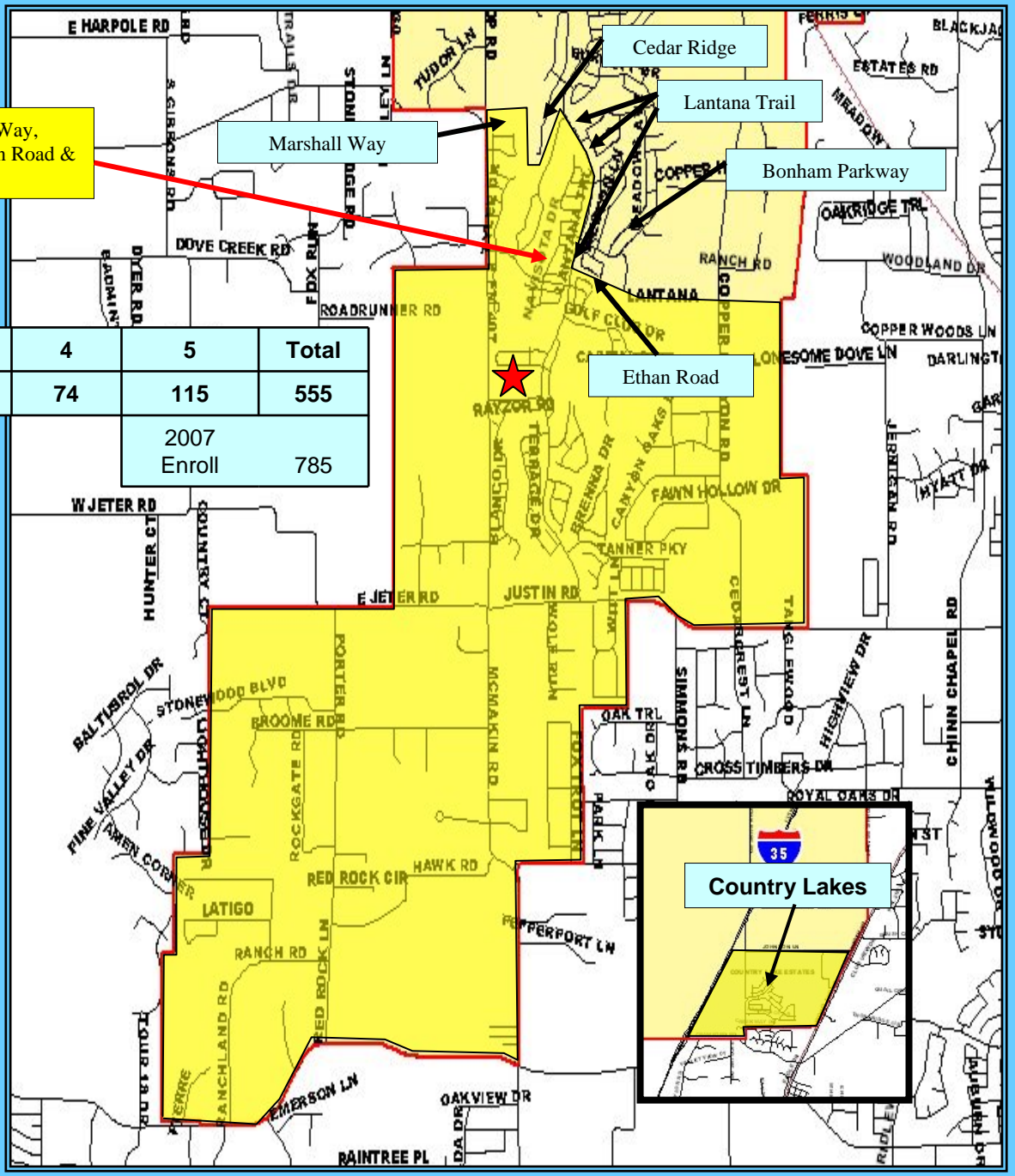

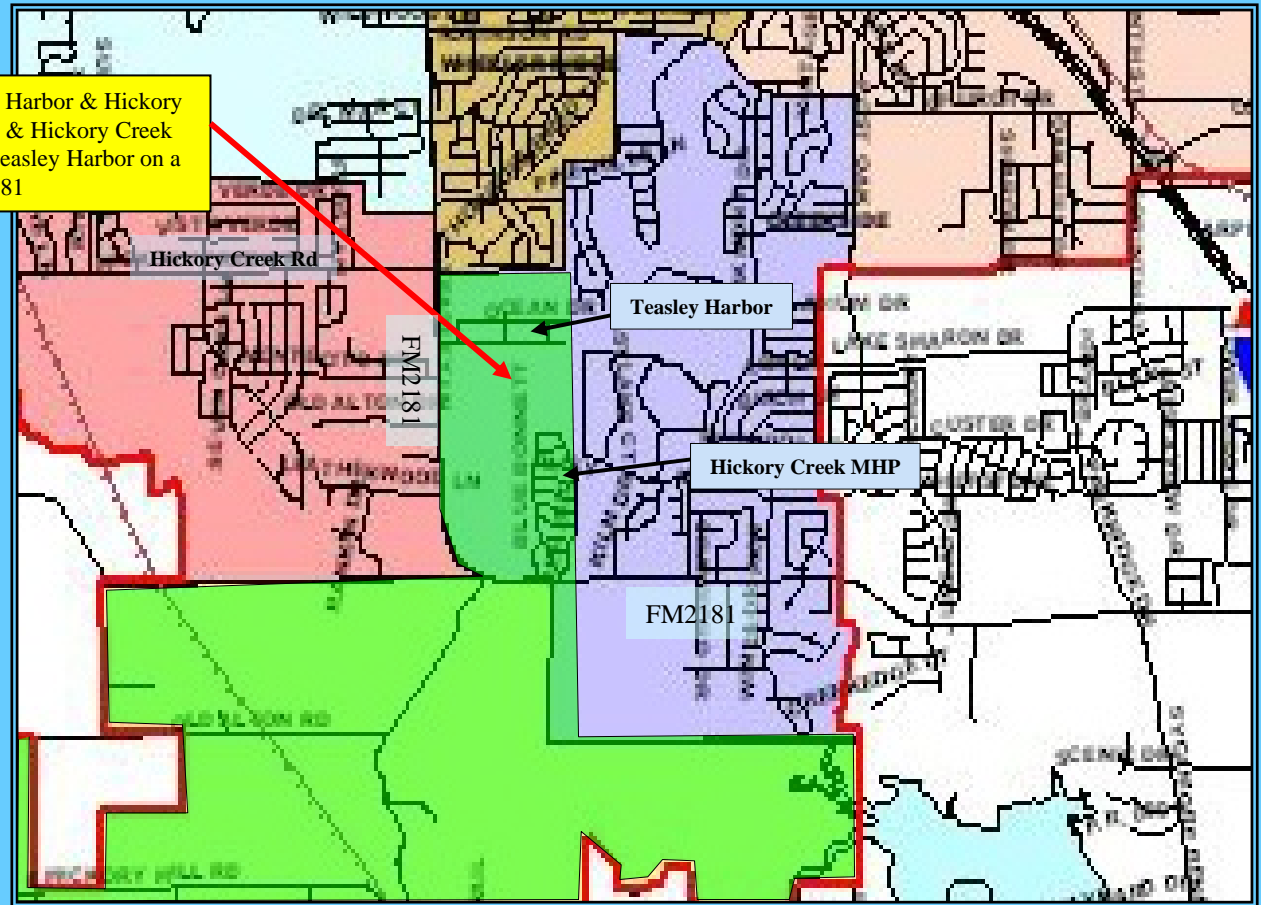
# Denton ISD 2008-2009 Proposed E.P. Rayzor Elementary Attendance Zone

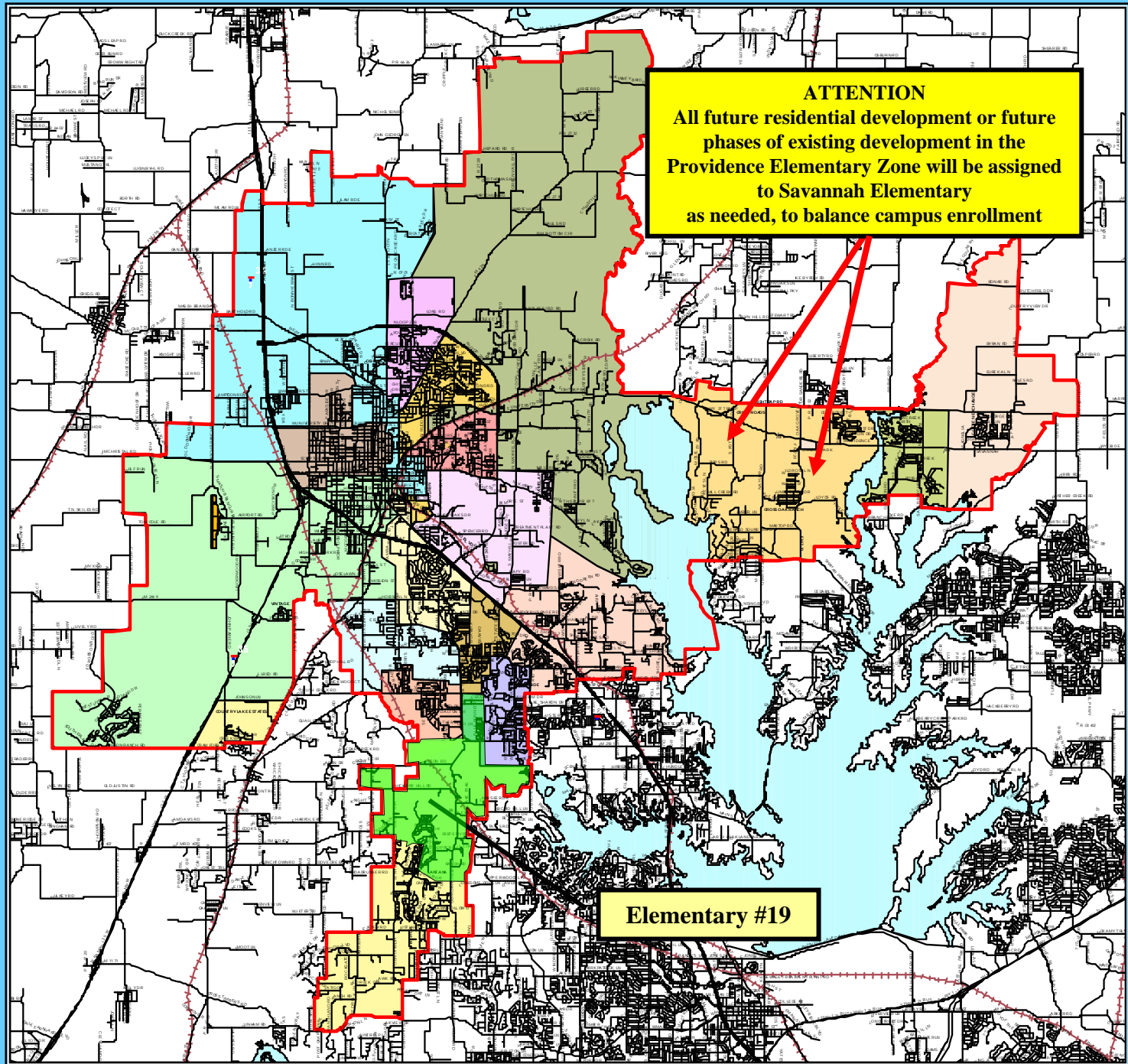

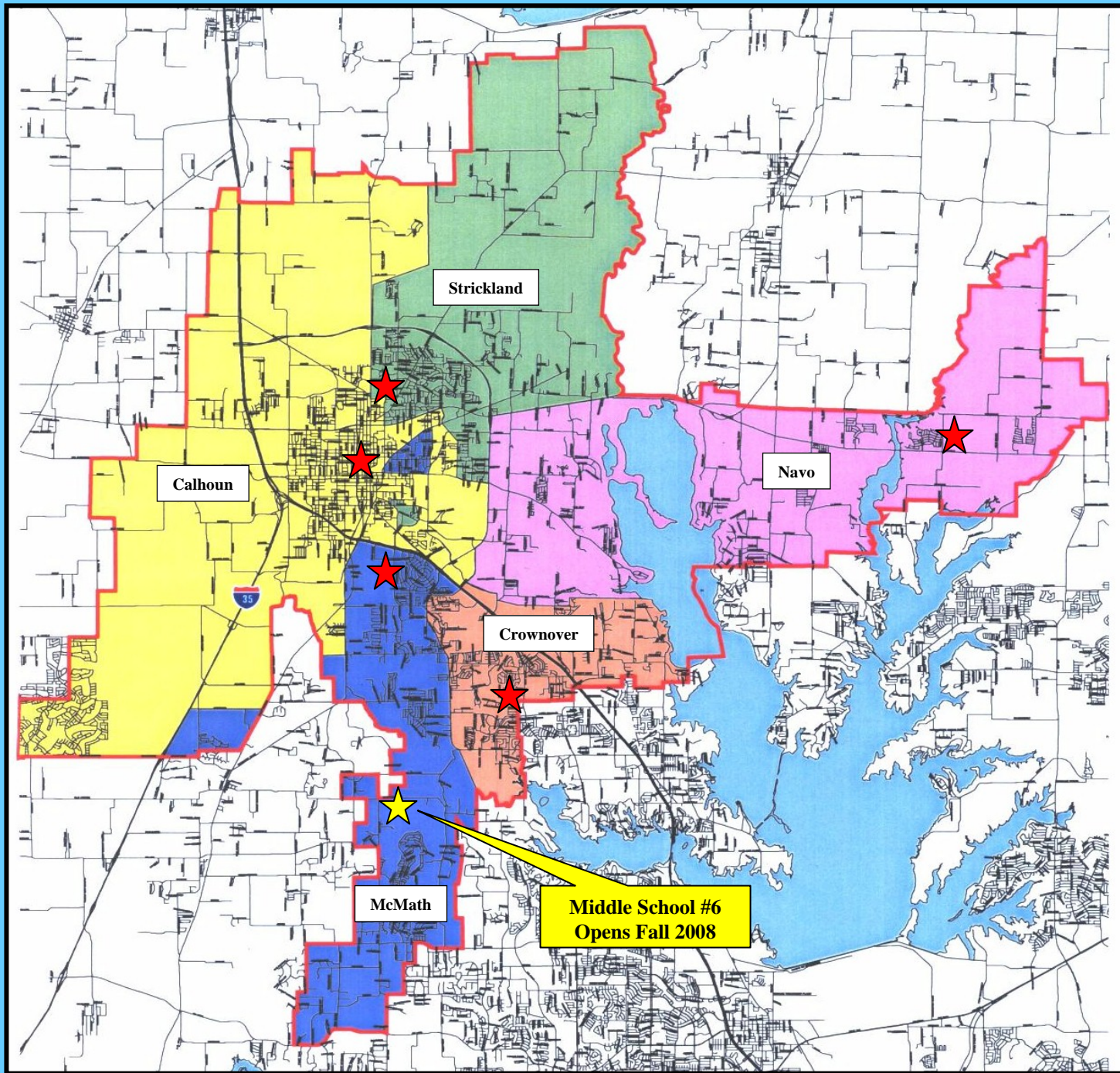

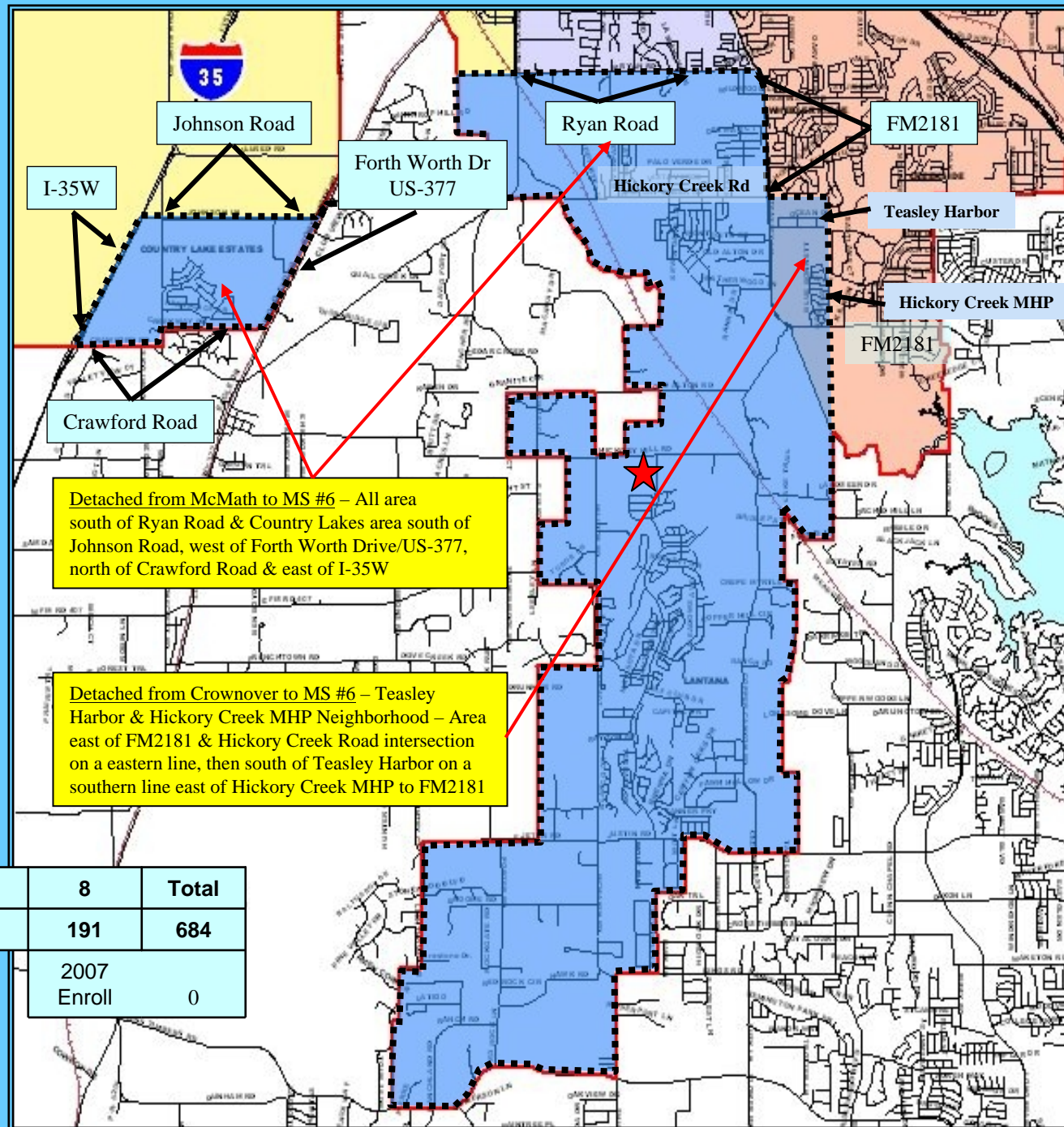

# DISD Proposed 2008-2009 Zoning Middle School #6



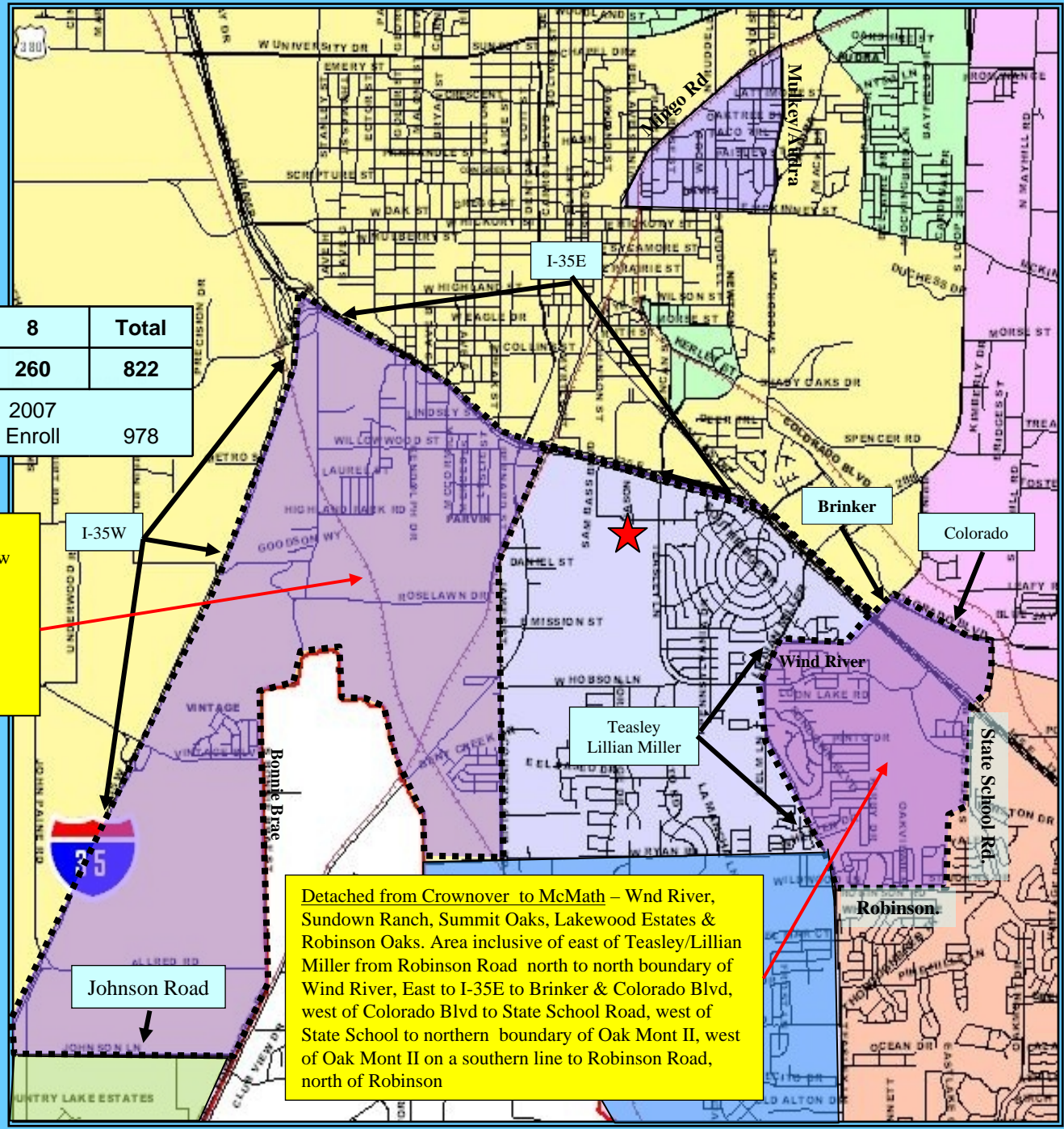

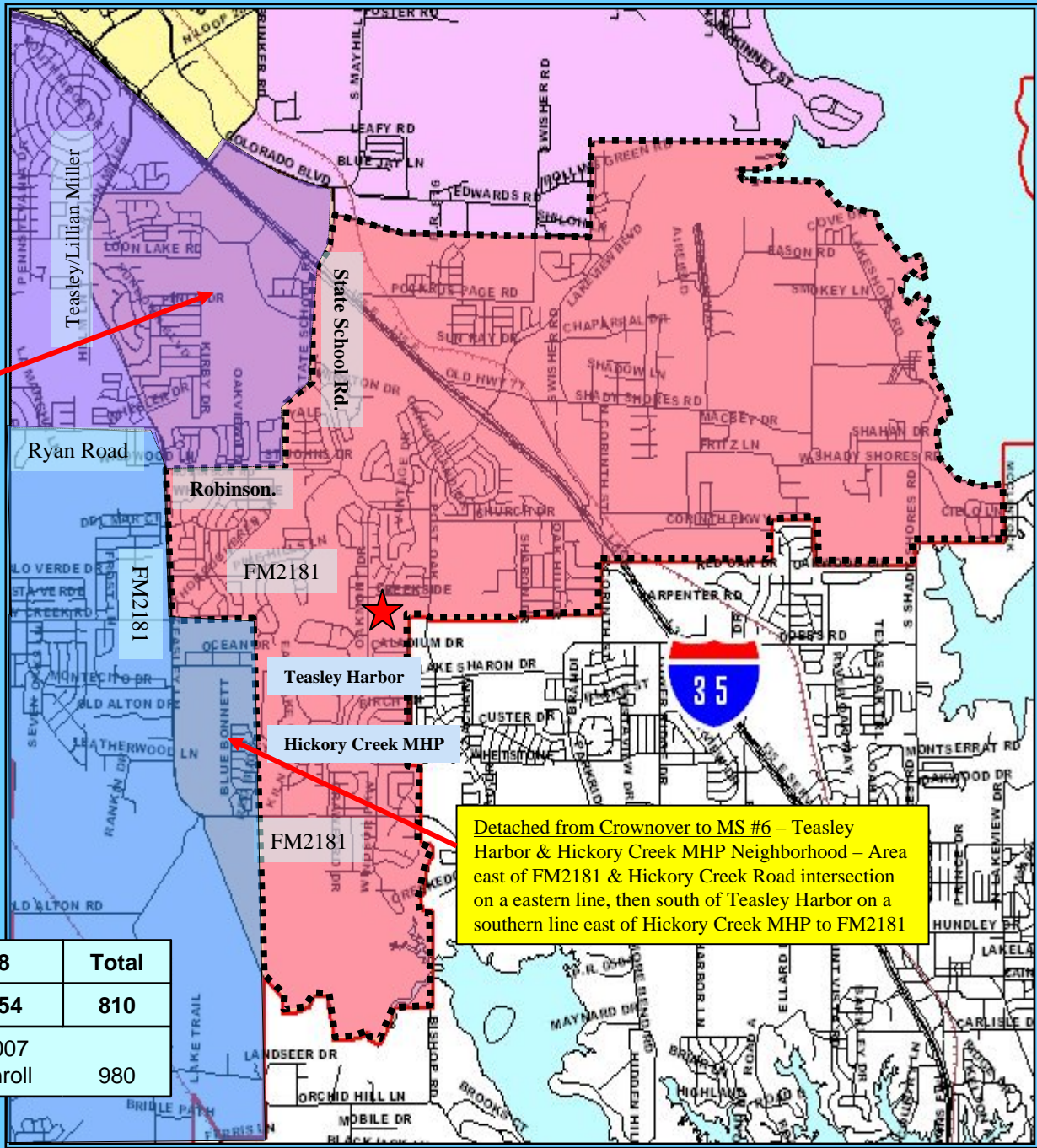

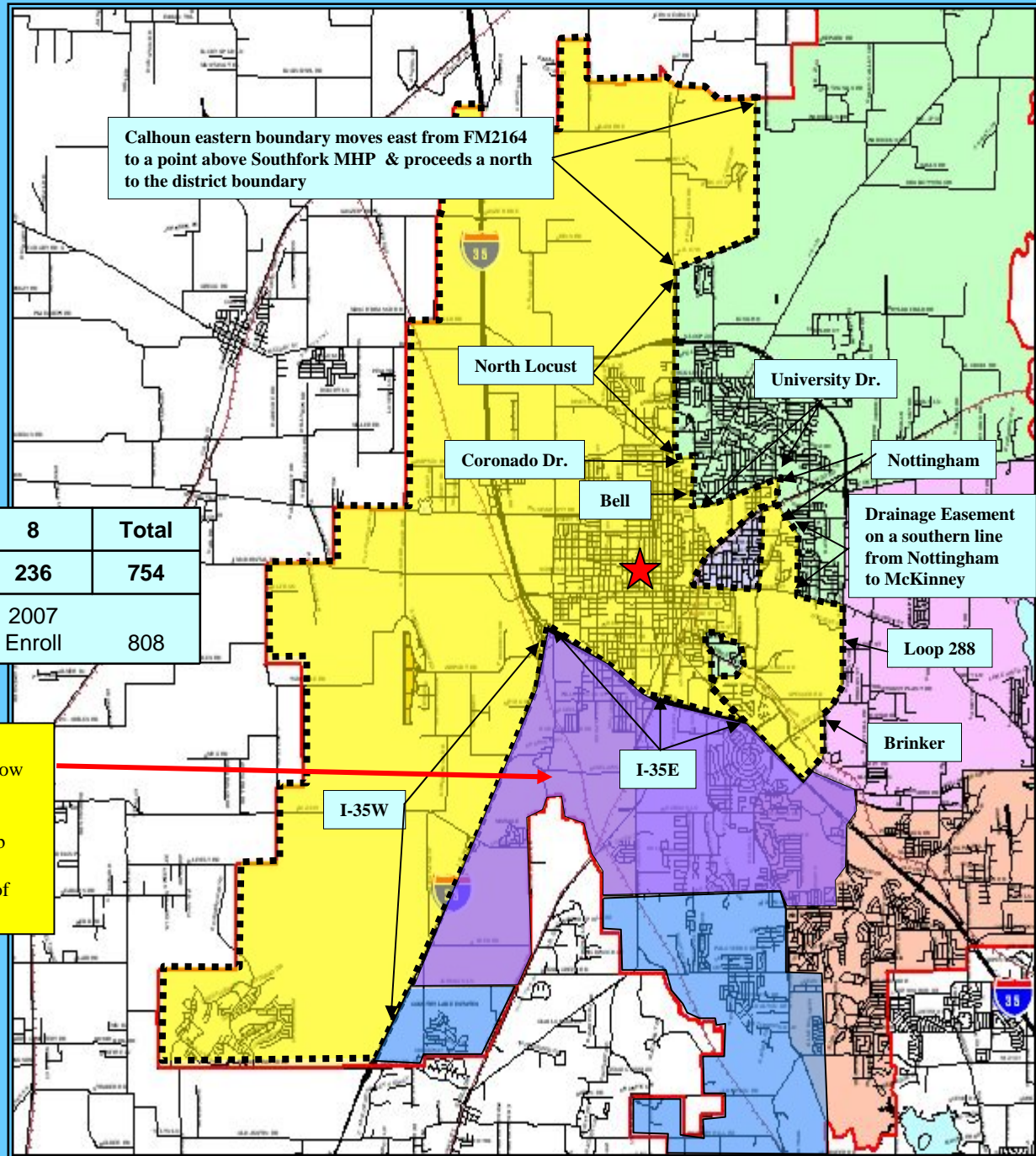

# Denton Independent School District Transfer Policy

## *Elementary Transfer Policy*

Fourth grade students re-zoned to a new attendance zone will be allowed to complete the fifth grade at their former campus. All other request for student transfer will be governed by DISD's regular transfer policy. In both cases, parents will be responsible for transportation.

## *Middle School Transfer Policy*

Middle school students having only one grade to complete at a given campus will be given the opportunity to stay at that given campus.

Siblings of these students in subsequent grades are not guaranteed a transfer, but these transfers will be considered by the building principal, and will be approved if there is space available.

In both cases, parents will be responsible for transportation. DISD will not provide transportation for middle school transfer students.
