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



LISD EB Enrollment, 2000-2024







LISD Enrollment, EB vs English Proficient Students, 2004 - 2024



Although LISD's overall enrollment numbers have declined over the years, our EB enrollment has continued to increase.




Comparison of EBs in LISD to Texas




Approximately 48,000 students are enrolled in Lewisville ISD schools.






Almost 5.5 million students are enrolled in Texas public schools.



Where Are Our Students From?


Our EBs come to us from countries all over the world. Many of our students have experienced interrupted or limited formal education opportunities as a result of conflicts and circumstances occurring in their home countries prior to enrolling in LISD. Immigrants from countries such as Burma / Myanmar, Honduras, Ukraine, and Venezuela all have Temporary Protected Status in the United States.

EB Language Program Participation in Texas vs LISD, 2024-2025




Historical Data Participation of Dual Language in LISD

Second Language Acquisition: What Does The Research Tell Us?


According to research on second language acquisition, it takes:

- 6 months to 2 years to become conversationally proficient in a language.
- 5 to 7 years to develop the language needed for cognitively and academically demanding skills and processes.
- For students with interrupted formal education, it may take 7 to 9 years to develop cognitive academic language proficiency.


Despite what this research tells us, EBs are regularly expected to demonstrate mastery of content and language skills on state assessments much sooner than they are linguistically ready.



EB Graduation Rates for Graduation Classes of 2012-2024




