Principal's Report:

The school year is off to a strong start as we near the end of the first quarter. Incompletes have been higher than usual, particularly among the freshman class, but those numbers are improving as students continue to complete and submit their work.

The **Veteran's Memorial Garden** is nearing completion. Flyers are being distributed to local businesses for table sponsorships. The new flag has been installed, and the space has a calm, welcoming atmosphere.

Fall sports are wrapping up after a season filled with several injuries. The focus is now shifting toward preparations for winter sports.

The **Booster Club**, in partnership with the school, purchased a side-by-side vehicle for use at athletic events and other school functions. It will be a valuable addition to the athletic department. Planning is already underway for the Booster Club Auction, scheduled for **January 24, 2026**.

The **Veteran's Day celebration** will be held on **November 6**, with invitations mailed and speakers confirmed. In addition, the band and choir will perform downtown with other local high schools on **November 10** in honor of Veterans Day.
