


Analysis: There is a .17% decrease in overall student attendance this year compared to last year. Although a slight decrease, it can be noted that an increase in cold/flu symptoms could likely be a contributing factor to this percentage.

Benchmark Testing:

Freshmen and Sophomore students took the Renaissance Star Tests for both reading and math at the beginning of the year and again at the beginning of December. Throughout the semester all Freshmen and Sophomore students spent approximately 1 hour per week on the intervention resource Freckle.



Winter data shows that approximately 30% of freshmen and 32% of sophomore students met/exceeded the 70th percentile rank in reading. For math, 29% of freshmen and 33% of sophomores met/exceeded the 70th percentile rank.

Throughout the semester Junior students worked through ACT preparation activities through the resource, Progress Learning. Students completed a practice ACT test in August and again in December to monitor growth.
