Board Member Qualifications

A person is eligible to serve as a Board member if the person ~~he/she~~ is a ~~qualified~~an elector¹ of the district. ~~An “elector” means an individual qualified to vote under Section 2, Article II of the Oregon Constitution. The individual must be 18 years of age or older, registered to vote at least 20 calendar days immediately preceding any election in the manner provided by law and has~~must have been a resident within the district for one year immediately preceding the election or appointment. If the district and the position sought is one elected or nominated by zone, the person must also reside in the zone from which the person is nominated except as authorized by law. ~~Additionally, if the district is zoned, the individual must meet the requirements of ORS 332.124—332.126.~~

~~A~~No person who is an employee of the district is not eligible to serve as a Board member while so employed. A person who is an employee of a public charter school may not serve as a member of the Board of the district in which the public charter school that employs the person is located. ~~[A district or public charter school substitute bus driver in a district with an average daily membership of 50 or less may serve as a Board member.]~~
