#### **Board Goal**

In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

#### Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the sixth grading cycle (April 13, 2015 – June 4, 2015). Also, the overall attendance for the 2014-2015 school year is provided. Finally, there is attendance comparison for the two years prior.

#### **Objectives**

- District-wide totals based on number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report
- Attendance figures are based on 38 instructional days (sixth cycle)
- Attendance for the school year is based on 177 instructional days

### **Operational Impact**

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

#### Results

- The total attendance percentage for the Denton ISD for Cycle 6 is 95.7%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for 12<sup>th</sup> grade students at 91.1 % followed by 11<sup>th</sup> grade students at 94.4%
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5<sup>th</sup> and 4<sup>rd</sup> grades, 97.1% and 96.7%.
- The district total for 2014-2015 is 95.8%
- 6<sup>th</sup> cycle reflects testing days and final exam days
