
- Parking lots and Drives are 100% complete.
- Roofing is 98% dried in. Metal trim work is left to complete.
- Masonry is 95% complete.
- Windows and glazing are 80% complete.





- Main Entrance steel is complete.
- Roof blocking for windows being installed.
- Wall and window flashing at Main Entrance is being installed.





- Classroom s at 4th and 5th Grade levels are being painted.
- Mechanical units in corridors have been installed in K and 1st Level and 4th and 5th Level wings.
- Corridor wall tile is complete in K and 1st Level and 4th and 5th Level wings.






- Electrical panels in Electrical Rooms are having wire pulled to them and breakers installed.

Safety and Security

- Add new camera locations to all elementary,
 middle and high schools
- Replace all existing cameras at all schools
 except those that already have High Definition
 (HD) cameras including Braswell High, Guyer
 High's new wing, Rodriguez Middle, Adkins
 Elementary, Bell Elementary and the Support
 Services Building.

- The Headend storage and old software will be replaced.
- Project will begin with schools first, high schools, elementary schools, middle schools then support buildings and is anticipated to begin Summer 2019.

Cabling Project

- Will replace classroom and hallway network wire location.
- Designate a new IDF and MDF for the following locations; Ryan High, McMath Middle, Fred Moore High, Evers Elementary, Hodge Elementary, Houston Elementary, and McNair Elementary.

 Collapsing all networking wiring into a single project, it is hoped to reduce the "per drop" cost and save the District money.

 The schools that are being renovated will be coordinated with that schedule.

Updated Wireless Network (WiFi)
