Teaching Learning & Relevance

- Data Retreat
 - Conducted 8/3 & 8/4. High School ELA & Math departments attended to review current academic achievement and growth data. The retreat generated a revised action plan associated with literacy and numeracy goals. Action timelines have been established for the 2022-23 school year.
- A leadership group has been meeting regularly since the start of May to facilitate the transition to the new learning management system (LMS) called Canvas. This small group has assisted Dean Alderton with the setup of the technology. This team has also developed common course structures for all high school teachers to implement. They have also created directions and training resources to complete the work independently. This group will continue to facilitate during August Inservice days.
- High school departments have been meeting throughout the summer months to progress on their academic work with learning targets and success criteria. They have also begun working on the transition to Canvas.
- The high school has been implementing Redefining Ready indicators for several years. We will be joining a formal cohort this coming school year. We are currently in the planning process with CESA 9 to determine cohort needs and action steps for the school year.
