Mississippi Ethics Commission Statement of Economic Interest – Due On or Before May 1, 2009

State law requires board members to annually file a Statement of Economic Interest form, available from the Mississippi Ethics Commission. Incumbent office holders must file on or before May 1 of each year. Appointees of offices required to file must submit a statement of economic interest form within 30 days of their appointment.

The form has changed for 2009 and you MUST complete the form online on your computer BEFORE printing the form. Then, you sign the statement in the presence of a notary public and mail. DO NOT USE THE OLD FORM. IF YOU DO – THE FORM WILL BE REJECTED.
