Mississippi Ethics Commission Statement of Economic Interest – Due On or Before May 1, 2009

State law requires board members to annually file a Statement of Economic Interest form, available from the Mississippi Ethics Commission. Incumbent office holders must file on or before May 1 of each year. Appointees of offices required to file must submit a statement of economic interest form within 30 days of their appointment.

The form has changed for 2009 and you **MUST** complete the form online on your computer **BEFORE** printing the form. Then, you sign the statement in the presence of a notary public and mail. **DO NOT USE THE OLD FORM. IF YOU DO – THE FORM WILL BE REJECTED.**

You can find the new form at www.ethics.state.ms.us. You must file this before May 1st of each year.
