ACTION ITEM

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On August 11, 2025, the Board of Trustees of the North East Independent School District ordered an election to be held on November 4, 2025. Texas Election Code, Sec. 67.03, requires that the governing body canvass the election results.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION

The election was held on November 4, 2025. The North East Independent School District bond proposal consisted of five propositions. Proposition A was approved by 60.4% of the voters who cast a ballot. A total of 41,349 voters voted "For" Proposition A, while 27,099 voters voted "Against" Proposition A.

Proposition B was approved by 56.6% of the voters who cast a ballot. A total of 38,585 voters voted "For" Proposition B, while 29,563 voters voted "Against" Proposition B.

Proposition C was approved by 50.1% of the voters who cast a ballot. A total of 34,117 voters voted "For" Proposition C, while 33,967 voters voted "Against" Proposition C.

Proposition D was rejected by 53.15% of the voters who cast a ballot. A total of 31,779 voters voted "For" Proposition D, while 36,054 voters voted "Against" Proposition D.

Proposition E was rejected by 50.27% of the voters who cast a ballot. A total of 33,718 voters voted "For" Proposition E, while 34,085 voters voted "Against" Proposition E.

BUDGETARY CONSIDERATION

The election was funded from the 199-41-702-99-702-6439-0000 account.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the North East Independent School District Board of Trustees approve the attached resolution as submitted.
