Ace it! Tutoring Fast Facts

Program Objectives:

Achieve academic improvement

- Curriculum is targeted to essential skills in reading and math

Be conveniently located

- Delivered at the school or community location

Provide an enjoyable and inspiring learning environment

- Students enjoy attending and learning

Instructional Model:

In-person, small class instruction to meet individual student needs

- Begins with an assessment to determine specific learning needs
- Students are placed in small classes (no more than 8 per class) based on their learning needs and ability levels
- Teachers provide instruction on learning objectives, motivate students and reward them for their achievement and effort
- All Ace it! Tutoring programs are aligned to state and district standards to help students learn skills that are on standardized tests

Curriculum Research:

Curriculum is based on research, best practices and common sense

- The Reading curriculum is based on the National Reading Panel (NRP) research and best practices, and designed to be systematic, explicit and intensive
- The Math curriculum content and process standards are based on those outlined by the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics (NCTM)
