

Student Crossing Restrictions

Elementary Students:

- A. Crossing with No Assistance
 - 2 lanes of traffic
 - 25 MPH
 - 175 ft. visibility each direction
 - No more than 6 cars per minute
- B. Crossing with Crossing Guard
 - 3 lanes of traffic
 - 30 MPH.
 - 175 ft. visibility each direction
- C. Crossing with School Bus Lights
 - 3 lanes of traffic
 - 30 MPH
 - 175 ft. visibility each direction
- D. Crossing with Pedestrian Lights and Crossing Guard
 - 5 lanes of traffic
 - 35 MPH
 - 175 ft. visibility

Middle School Students

- A. Crossing with No Assistance
 - 3 lanes of traffic
 - 30 MPH
 - 175 ft. visibility each direction
 - No more than 8 cars per minute
- B. Crossing with School Bus Lights
 - 3 lanes of traffic
 - 35 MPH
 - 175 ft. visibility each direction
- C. Crossing with Pedestrian Lights
 - 3 lanes of traffic
 - 35 MPH
 - 175 ft. visibility each direction.
- D. Crossing with Pedestrian Lights and Crossing Guard
 - 5 lanes of traffic
 - 35 MPH
 - 175 ft. visibility each direction.

High School & Options Students

- A. Crossing with No Assistance
 - a. 3 lanes of traffic
 - b. 30 MPH
 - c. 175 ft. visibility both directions
 - d. No more than 10 cars per minute
- B. Crossing with School Bus Lights
 - a. 3 lanes of traffic
 - b. 35 MPH
 - c. 175 ft. visibility both directions
- C. Crossing with Pedestrian Lights
 - a. 6 lanes of traffic or:
 - b. 7 lanes of traffic with pedestrian island.
 - c. 40 MPH
 - d. 200 ft. visibility
