Subject: Information Item – Federal Funding for TRiO Student Support Services Program from the Department of Education.

Recommendation: Review information item.

Background and Rationale: The TRiO SSS Grant focuses on providing services to low-income, first-generation, and/or disabled students to increase their graduation and transfer rates to a 4-year college. Funds are used to support a cohort of 144 students that have been accepted into the program. This support includes academic and student support services, instructional materials, and other activities as allowed by the grant guidelines and funding.

Subject: TRiO SSS Year 11 Indirect Cost Rate

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you about the indirect cost rate, which is set at 8%, as well as how it is calculated. To determine the indirect cost rate, we take the total grant amount of \$272,364 and divide it by 1.08. This calculation yields a direct cost total of \$252,189. The difference between the grant total and the direct cost total results in the indirect cost amount of \$20,175. Details regarding the Unrestricted Indirect Cost Rate can be found on Page 2 of the TRiO SSS 25-26 Grant Award Notification.
