Product Selection Process

- Curriculum Council met with vendors and scored resources using a rubric focused on alignment with the dual language principles and the Illinois Comprehensive Literacy Plan.
- Survey indicated a need to continue a strong emphasis on foundational literacy and writing, as well as the availability of digital components.

- The pilot will take place on Nov. 4th and conclude on Dec. 20th
