We are required to hold a public meeting each year between September 1st and October 31st to update the governing board and community about the progress of capital improvements financed through bonds and/or overrides.

Bonds

In November 2022, CFSD voters authorized \$38.5 million in school improvement bonds for capital improvements across the school district. In April 2023, the first issuance was sold for \$14,956,400. In May 2025, the second issuance was sold for \$12,947,300.

2022 Capital Override

In November 2022, CFSD voters approved a \$2,000,000 capital outlay override for technology equipment and software, teaching and learning resources, and infrastructure. Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) were designated for FY 24 and for each fiscal year thereafter through FY 30. We intentionally planned for carryover funds in order to continue technology support for teachers and students as well as to fund instructional materials and resources for curriculum revision.
