The legislative advocacy agenda IASB members will consider November 20 at the IASB Delegate Assembly will frame the message of Iowa school boards to the 2021 legislature. The proposed platform before the delegate offers 30 resolutions, including five proposed priorities, along with continuing belief statements.

- A. Identify your delegate. Select a member of your board to represent you and submit their name to IASB so we can mail the materials to help the delegate prepare. We request the names by October 20 in order to prepare the mailing. For boards which have not yet selected a delegate, we'll send the packet to the superintendent and it can be passed on when you do. - B. Review the proposed platform as a board and ensure your delegate is prepared to vote on your behalf. The proposed platform has been vetted by the Legislative Resolutions Committee (LRC) and the IASB Board of Directors. The members overall, through Delegate Assembly, vote resolutions in, out or amended.
