What is a Summative Designation?

- Primary mechanism for school accountability under ESSA
- Multiple measures Index of academic achievement and student success
- Developed in deep collaboration with stakeholders throughout the state
- Designed to identify schools for supports and improvement
 - Including schools with subgroups needing support in otherwise high performing schools



What are the Designations?

| Exemplary | Schools performing in the top 10 percent of schools statewide, with no underperforming student groups . | |
|-------------------|---|--|
| Commendable | A school that has no underperforming student groups , a graduation rate greater than 67 percent, and whose performance is not in the top 10 percent of schools statewide. | |
| Underperforming | A school in which one or more student groups is performing at or below the level of the "all students" group in the lowest performing 5 percent of schools. | |
| Lowest Performing | A school that is in the lowest-performing 5 percent of schools in Illinois and any high school with a graduation rate of 67 percent or less. | |



4 Step Process

Collect and calculated Performance Data Convert to an Indicator
Score
(0 to 100)

Weight & aggregate to an Index Score

Rank order & compare to determine Summative Designation


- Percent Proficient

- Weighted according to the plan
- Rank ordered by All Student Group

Transparent Designations

Every school receives an annual designation on the Illinois Report Card. The designation is based on the school's overall data for all of the accountability indicators, as well as the data for individual student groups.
