

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

DIVISION OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION RULES GOVERNING HOME SCHOOL

Act 429 prohibits districts from charging home school or private school students for an endorsed concurrent credit course unless the district also charges public school students for the course. Act 430 requires public schools to adopt policies that allow private school and home school students to enroll in academic courses, provided that their enrollment will not create a financial loss for the district. Requires that a public school include provisions that apply to private school or home-schooled students, such as grade-level prerequisites, attendance, testing, coursework, grades, and conduct requires that these provisions be consistent with policies that apply to public school students.
