Re: Approve 2025-26 Program Plan

Recommendation:

It is the recommendation of the Superintendent to approve the 2025-26 Program Plan.

Background Information:

Annually the program plan allows for the district to employ and assign staff for the upcoming school year. Here are the proposed changes for the upcoming school year:

Reduction of 0.5 FTE Middle School Math - this position was unfilled by outside candidates with Matt Rich teaching 2 sections of 6th grade math. With the graduation of our 8th grade, we anticipate only having 6 sections of middle school math next year.

Middle School Math intervention - each grade level math class (not the accelerated classes) will have a learning behavior specialist integrated into the classroom. In the period after, for students who need additional math instructional support/intervention on an ongoing basis, they will have math intervention instead of Spanish.

Intermediate grades - 6 home rooms plus an additional teacher (Megan Ryder) for math and an additional teacher (Grace Shelly) for reading. Instead of a multi-age, we will have additional sections of math and reading while maintaining 6 homerooms. We will be offering accelerated math for all students who qualify.

Programming/Digital Literacy - Megan Ryder will be leading an additional special for about 9 weeks for each K-5 classroom on programming/digital literacy. This will be scheduled in addition to their current specials.
