SUGGESTED SCHOOL BOARD ACTION:

Report- no action necessary

DESCRIPTION:

School districts are required to provide extended school year (ESY) services to a student if the IEP team determines the services are necessary during a break in instruction in order to provide a free appropriate public education. ESY Services are provided to students who currently receive special education services and have data supporting eligibility in one of three areas: regression and recoupment of skills, self-sufficiency or unique needs. At least annually, individual determinations are made by reviewing student data at IEP team meetings. This summer, our ESY program will also serve students who have been determined eligible for recovery services due to a variety of circumstances related to the COVID-19 pandemic. For some students, this will be an extension of the length of time they spend in ESY each day and for others it will be attending the full ESY program for which they would not have otherwise been qualified. Each spring we continue to collect information from staff to finalize numbers of eligible students as IEP team determinations for ESY services are being made through the end of the school year. The numbers below reflect the current number of eligible students and the number of staff who have applied for ESY positions.
