Operation Help - Senior Class Pizza Party

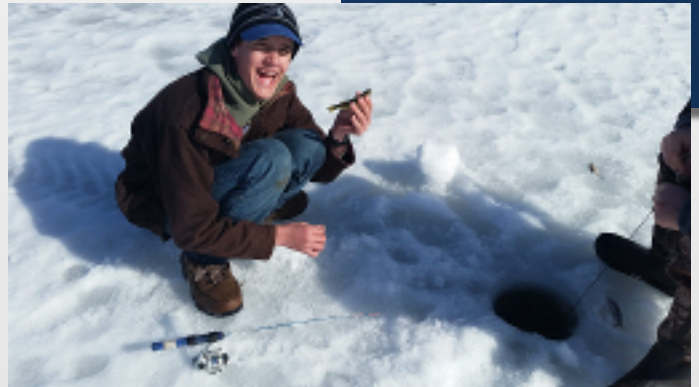
