Robstown Early College High School 2022-2023 Semester Exam Exemption Policy

The following exemption policy will be in effect for the 22-23 school year.

ONE SEMESTER COURSES /SPRING SEMESTER

During one-semester courses and the spring semester in yearlong courses, students will be eligible for exam exemptions.

Students in grades 9-12 may be exempt from the semester exam in each course if the following criteria are met:

- The student has maintained an average of 85 or higher during the semester in the course for which the exemption is granted.
- The student has no more than three unexcused absences in the course for which the exemption is granted.

 The date range consists of the following:

August 15, 2022- December 2, 2022 - for students taking a one-semester course in the Fall January 4, 2023- April 28, 2023- for Senior students taking one Semester Courses taken in the Spring January 4, 2023- May 12, 2023- for students taking one Semester Courses taken in the Spring August 15, 2022 - May 12, 2023 - for Senior Students taking Yearlong Courses August 15, 2022 - May 12, 2023 - for Yearlong Courses

Students who are exempt from an exam must report to class during the assigned testing period. Students will need to remain in class. If a student is exempt and fails to report to class for attendance forfeits the exemption. In such a case, a semester exam grade of "0" will be recorded on the report card unless the student makes up the exam during the scheduled time for test make-ups.

Students, who are exempt from the semester exam by grades and attendance, can also choose to take the exam to improve their semester average.

If a student chooses this option, he or she must adhere to the campus guidelines for all students who are required to take the exam.

The exam grade can only be used to improve the exempt student's semester average.
