<u>22133</u> School Executive Consulting, Inc.: School Executive Consulting, Inc. Principle Dr. Mike Moses provided Trustees with a superintendent search presentation delineating their respective services. The firm was founded in 2000 and the principles associated with the firm are Mr. David Thompson and Dr. Mike Moses. This firm brings a unique skill set in terms of background and services. Mr. Thompson is a school attorney who represents school districts and school boards. He has served as an officer with the Texas Association of School Boards and general counsel for the Texas Education Agency. Dr. Moses previously served as the Texas Commissioner of Education, was Deputy Chancellor and Professor of Educational Administration for the Texas Tech University System and is a former school superintendent in four Texas school districts. Trustees were presented with a suggested timeline indicating the possibility of having a Superintendent in place by early February 2014. The approximate cost breakdown would include the following:

- 1) Consultant fee \$22,000.00
- 2) Consultant expenses \$2,300.00 (Approximate)

- 3) Advertising fees -Texas search \$200.00, National search \$850.00 (Approximate)
- 4) Candidate travel expenses \$2,300.00 (Approximate)
- 5) Office supplies/postage \$150.00

The District will not be billed until the search is completed and Trustees are completely satisfied. The firm guarantees a free search if the superintendent leaves within the first year.
