Subject: Consider and possible Board action to approve Memorandum of Agreement between the San Elizario ISD and the Boys & Girls Club of El Paso
Date: June 11, 2025

HISTORY: The Boys & Girls Clubs of El Paso (BGCEP) has been awarded the federal Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant funds from the Texas Education Agency to provide Texas Afterschool Centers for students in Lorenzo G. Alarcon Elementary, Alfonso G. Borrego, Sr. Elementary, Josefa L. Sambrano Elementary and Ann M. Garcia-Enriquez Middle School. The afterschool center is intended to improve the academic performance of participating students in core academic subjects, such as reading and math, and offer students a broad array of enrichment activities (MOA, 2022).

RATIONALE: The BGCEP will serve approximately 245 students, with each child completing sixty days or more of attendance. The children are identified and recruited through coordinated consultation with SEISD Leadership.

BUDGET IMPACT: All costs are covered by the Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant. The SEISD will commit to provide the facilities to operate the program.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION: It is the administrative recommendation that the Board of Trustees approve the Memorandum of Agreement between the SEISD and the BGCEP to start the afterschool centers for the 2025 – 2026 school year.
