Inclement Weather Communication Plan (Revised 12/4/2023)

Neah-Kah-Nie Staff, Students, and Parents,

In case of inclement weather and/or a power outage, here is the school district's Delayed Start

Monday-Friday
5:00 a.m. Road checks by First Student and NKN School Superintendent 5:00 a.m.

First Student and superintendent will discuss road conditions to determine if a school delay or school closure is necessary. If the decision is to cancel or delay school, the superintendent will notify staff.

6:00 a.m. Public notice of school cancelation or delay by the school district will be available on the school district's Facebook and website pages (nknsd.org), Flashalert, and

School Messenger.

In the case of inclement weather or a power outage, the school district will make timely and safe decisions based on current conditions. In case of a power outage, the school district will communicate with Tillamook PUD staff to determine next steps.

If there is a two hour delay, elementary staff will report to work at 9:30; school will begin at 10:00. At the secondary level, staff will report to work at 10:00 and school will begin at 10:45.

Parents, if there is a two hour delay, your child will need to be at the bus stop two hours later than the regular bus pick up time, for example, if your child is normally picked up at 8:10 a.m., with a two hour delay, your child will be picked up at 10:10 a.m.

Breakfast will not be provided on a delayed start day.

Contact Esther (esthert@nknsd.org) or Shawn (shawnl@nknsd.org) if you need assistance or have questions. There will also be upcoming FAFSA help opportunity nights coming up January-March!

WHAT STUDENTS CAN DO NOW TO PREPARE

- Prior-Prior Year (PPY) Tax Information: The 2024-2025 FAFSA will use 2022 tax information for students and their families to determine eligibility for federal student aid. They should ensure that this information is completed and accessible.
- All students and parents contributing to the FAFSA will need a FSA ID. If you don't already have
 one, you can go here to create an account. You will need your social security number and a
 personal email and phone number for each account created. Make sure and save your log-in
 information somewhere!

OR from newly accrued second meal charges will receive charge balance statements through email or will be notified by phone calls







