



## Brownwood ISD School Safety Report 2020-2021

Below you will find a list of security measures that have been taken or will be taken on each BISD campus to increase the safety of our BISD students and personnel.

### Brownwood High School

- Additional security cameras installed
- Seventeen new Motorola radios and a new Repeater have been purchased

### Brownwood Middle School

- Fifteen new Motorola radios have been purchased
- Additional security cameras installed

### Brownwood Intermediate School

- New door access controls with keyless entry installed
- New security cameras installed
- Six new Motorola radios and a new Repeater have been purchased

### East Elementary

- Additional fencing to secure the playground was installed
- Two new Motorola radios have been purchased

### Woodland Heights

- Removed hazardous fencing along entry corridor.
- Three new Motorola radios have been purchased

### Northwest Elementary

- New road and point of entry for a safer student drop-off and pick-up completed with BISD and the City of Brownwood and implemented August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020
- Three new Motorola radios have been purchased

### District-wide

- The BISD School Safety Committee has met several times and reviewed and revised our BISD Emergency Operations Plan.
- The BISD School Safety Audit required every 3-years was completed August 2020 and submitted to the Texas School Safety Center.
- Continuation of an additional half-time Student Resources Officer (SRO) to support all BISD campuses.
- Twenty new Motorola radios dispersed throughout the Central Support Staff, Transportation, Maintenance, Custodial, BAHS, and Headstart.



- Installation of central distribution systems on each campus for the metering and controlling of cleaners and disinfectants for custodial staff.
- Continuation of StayALERT Anonymous online/Text/Phone reporting system.



- Continuation of the Raptor® visitor management school security system which screens for sex offenders, alerts staff of custody violations, and provides everything schools needed to screen persons during check-in.
- Continuation of the Watch D.O.G.S Program across the district, PK-6.
