


SCHOOL SAFETY: UNITY'S GRANT PROVIDES DIGITAL MAPPING

BACK IN 2021, WISCONSIN ACT 109 CREATED AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE STATE OF WISCONSIN TO PROVIDE GRANT FUNDS TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF WORKING WITH LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TO DEVELOP HIGH-QUALITY DIGITAL MAPS OF THEIR CAMPUSES. THE PURPOSE OF THE DIGITAL MAPS IS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT, FIRE DEPARTMENTS, AND OTHER PUBLIC SERVICE AGENCIES TO HAVE QUICK, MEANINGFUL ACCESS TO MAPS OF SCHOOL CAMPUSES SHOULD AN EVENT OCCUR THAT SUCH ACCESS IS NEEDED. IN

2023, UNITY RECEIVED GRANT FUNDS TO UNDERGO THE YEAR-AND-A-HALF LONG PROCESS TO COMPLETE THE DIGITAL MAPPING PROJECT.

Unity School District is one of 20 school districts in Wisconsin that receive federal funding called Impact Aid. This funding is provided to districts that have a reduced local tax base on account of having non-taxable federal properties contained within the district such as national forest land and/or Native American reservations. Unity receives funding for students, parents, and community members who live on Native American land, are employed by any and all federal entities (this includes forestry, casinos, Army Corps of Engineers, etc., live on federal land or low-income housing, or serve in the U.S. Uniformed Services/work for the Federal Government. If you or someone you know fits into any of these categories, please encourage them to complete the Impact Aid Survey, which can be found on the Unity School District website, as it directly impacts the Impact Aid funds Unity receives each year.
