Return to Learn 2021 -

Currently, the DuPage County Health Department does not support any of the "Test To Stay" programs, as they have claimed there is not enough information about them to validate their endorsement. I have the District Certified Nurse looking into the SHIELD and Achieve Health Management programs to determine if they could be implemented in each building. The goal would be to reduce the amount of quarantine time for students in order that they missed fewer days of in person instruction. Remote learning is not an option under the current guidelines from the Illinois State Board of Education.

The Tentative Plan has been made available to the public and I would be happy to answer any questions at this time.

Summer School Summary –

Finance Committee of the Whole -

At this special meeting of the Board of Education on Monday, September 13th, two topics will be addressed:

- A summary of the summer projects from Mr. Leyden;
- A Finance Committee of the Whole to review the FY 2022 Budget

Like last year, a tour will not be required as many of the summer projects were scaled down and can be effectively shared in a brief presentation from Mr. Leyden. The Finance Committee of the Whole will look similar to a regular meeting, with the notable exception that no decisions will be made or recommended for approval.

1. A student growth goal (required under the Illinois School Code);
2. Work on developing committees and focus groups to acquire feedback and generate potential options on issues contained in the Strategic Plan;
3. Implement social emotional supports for students and staff.
