BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- As stated in Board Policy BBB (LEGAL), the Board of Trustees consists of seven members serving terms of three years, with elections held annually.
- The terms of one-third of the Board Members, or as near to one-third as possible, expire each year.
- Election of Board Members is by position or place in accordance with Texas law.
- The positions for election this year are Place 4, currently held by Forrest Collins and Place 5, currently held by Bobby J Rigues.
- With January 16, 2019 being the first date to file an application for a place on the ballot, the memo titled Important Dates for the May 4, 2019 Trustee Election is included for your information and review.
- An Order of Election will be presented to the Board of Trustees for consideration and approval at the January 22, 2019 board meeting.

January 16	first day to file for place on ballot
February 15	deadline to file for place on ballot (5:00 PM) deadline to order a general election to be held
February 19	deadline for write-in candidates to file declaration of write-in candidacy (5:00 PM)
February 25	conduct ballot position drawing (8:30 AM)
April 4	last day to register to vote/change address for the May 4, 2019 election
April 22	first day of early voting by personal appearance
April 30	last day of early voting by personal appearance
May 4	ELECTION DAY 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM
May 7 - 15	canvass election – date determined by Board of Trustees
