

Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) 2019-2023:

The purpose of the CIP is to identify goal areas that focus on: strengthen district systems; engage community partners; promote well-rounded learning environments; and elevate equitable learning outcomes for traditionally struggling populations.

The CIP is the first part of the process in developing the district plan for Student Success Act Funds (spring of 2020)

Goal 1: All Morrow County School District students will demonstrate academic achievement growth proportionate to or above their Oregon peers using a variety of measures. Students are expected to grow academically a minimum of one year at every grade level, in preparation for graduation.

- Identification of specific instructional gaps within ELA and math instruction and professional development aligned to strengthen instructional practices in those areas.
 - o Passage writing; higher level question writing; writing processes

Goal 2: MCSD attendance rates will improve at a rate consistent or higher than the state average.

- Each school will work on strategies specific to their attendance concerns using their CARE coordinator, SRO, and district attendance processes. Each community will also work with the ESD's chronic attendance coordinator to support community engagement and education as needed.

Goal 3: Each School will provide opportunities aligned to STEAM activities for their students during the school day and/or during optional after school/Friday opportunities.

-Robotics/Wind challenge activities tied into elementary after school and Friday school offerings

-Robotics / Wind challenge activities tied into 7-12 science and CTE curriculum

-STEAM activities incorporated into June and August enrichment activities
