Re: Bid Results for the Waste Removal Services

Attached please find a memo from Harry Lau, Administrator of Operations with a recommendation for Waste Removal Services for the 2014-2015 school year. Also attached is the bid tabulation with the details from the three vendors that responded to the request for proposal.

We analyzed the cost data for the various types of waste removal containers LPS uses (8 yard containers and 10 yard containers) and the frequency of services to each building (once a week, twice a week, etc) to determine an estimate for annual costs. This provided a method to compare the three proposals. We are recommending the vendor with the low bid for annual services of \$63,695 to Rizzo Environmental Services.

Mr. Lau is also recommending that we pilot a program for recycling at a few schools. The goal is to reduce the amount of waste we currently have in our containers which in the long run would reduce our waste removal costs. This is for your information only, as it will not be on the agenda for Board approval. Attached is information indicating what types of materials can and cannot be recycled, and cost considerations. We will update you with the results of the pilot program when the information is available.

We would like to discuss the bid results for the waste removal at the Tuesday, May 27, 2014 Building and Site Committee Meeting. As always, let me know if you have any questions. Thank you.

Recommendation Solid Waste Removal

On Wednesday, May 14, 2014, I opened Sealed Bids for Waste Removal, for the 2014/2015 school year. Three (3) vendors participated in the bid and all had representatives present for the bid opening.

After review of the bid documentation, I am recommending and seeking approval to award the contract for solid waste removal, for the 2014/2015 school year, to Rizzo Environmental Services.

The three vendors that participated were:

### Rizzo Environmental Services, quoting approximate annual cost of \$63,694.80.

Republic Services Inc., quoting approximate annual cost \$71,604.00.

Waste Management, quoting approximate annual cost \$73,036.08.

I would also like to recommend and seek approval to engage Rizzo Environmental Services, in supporting Livonia Public Schools, in starting a recycling program to help LPS reduce our solid waste and lower our carbon foot print. Engaging a recycling program of this type would allow Livonia Public Schools to send less solid waste to Michigan landfills by recycling the following materials; Plastic Bottles, all Steel and Tin cans, all paper, Plastic Containers #3-#7, Phone Books, Plastic Bags, Junk Mail, Pots and Pans as well as Magazines and Catalogs. This would also reduce our cost for solid waste pick- ups.

For the Pilot Program, I would like to recommend starting at a few elementary schools and progressing to the district as a whole.


