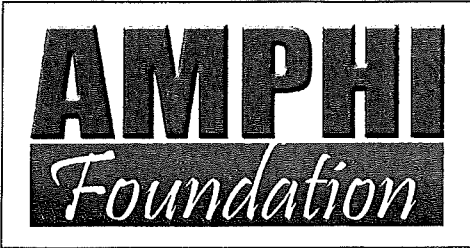

## Grant Proposal

**Project Title:** The University of Arizona Campus Visit

Refugee students and their ELL classmates will tour the University of Arizona campus to set goals for post-graduation careers, see UA schools, departments, libraries, and dorms with their own eyes. We would like to take the whole ELD Department and inspire all our students with the amazing opportunities that UA offers. There are approximately 100 ELL students at Amphi who will benefit from this project.

We will develop a tour route enlisting help from UA student guides; we will plan small group discussions and interest surveys in collaboration with AHS Counselors in order to incorporate authentic communication in English for students who are still learning the language. For many newcomers in the US, visiting a university and understanding its availability through good grades and scholarships would be an eye-opening experience, and a strong motivational tool.

- Students will have a virtual tour of the UA before going on a trip;
- Students will design and conduct interest surveys in order to decide which areas of the campus to focus on;
- Teachers and students will design a campus tour in collaboration with the The University of Arizona college advisor working at AHS, and UA guidance counseling dept.;
- Teachers will create plans of activities and small group discussions related to the students' interests and observations;
- Students will write reports on their field trip observations and experiences;
- In subsequent lessons, ELL 12<sup>th</sup> graders will access and fill out FAFSA, and other grade levels will re-examine their transcripts, path to graduation, and post-graduation plans.

The students will be graded on the surveys, field trip reports, speaking skills during discussions, and graduation planning activities. The grading will be based on Arizona State ELD Standards.
