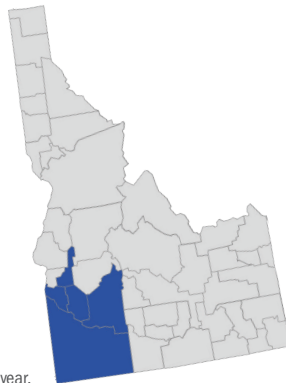

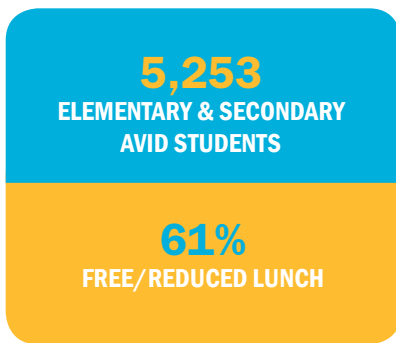

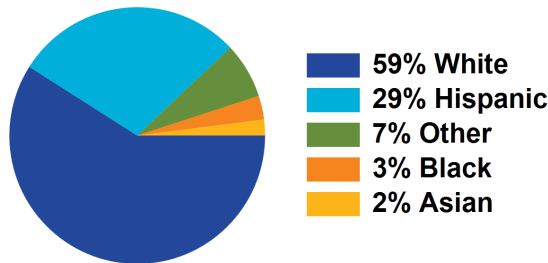

AVID National Demonstration Schools

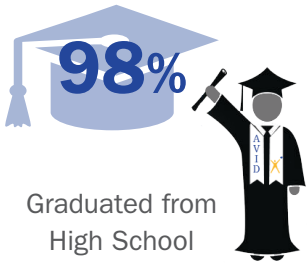
