Under Old Business:

Site Council reviewed minutes from January 2017 meeting and unanimously approved them.

Mr. Erb presented documents from the Council of Great City Schools - Road Maps for Parents. These documents were considered by the Site Council to be a part of the Council's implementation of School Improvement Plan Success Indicator DSC1.3: The school's leadership plans for and implements professional development preparing teachers to support parents in the education of their children by providing in-classroom opportunities and at-home opportunities for parents.

The site council agreed the documents would be helpful to parents and asked Mr. Erb to present them to the Applegate Staff to gain their support for disseminating the documents.

The Site Council spent 75 minutes comparing sections from Williams Elementary School Handbook to the Applegate School Handbook.

The site council agreed that the Applegate School Student Handbook, written for K-8, can be confusing to some parents as information for K-5 and 6-8 are contained in the same sections. Also, the council agreed some of the content which is secondary in nature is better separated from the K-5 document. It was decided at this meeting that Applegate School should have a single handbook, with two major sections: one for grades K-5, and one for grades 6-8.

Handbooks from both schools were marked up, and the next step is to determine what should be included in a K-5 handbook, using Williams Elementary School as a guide, and what sections should be in a 6-8 handbook, using Applegate's handbook as a guide.
