

Subject: Resolution to Establish Non-business Days for Public Information Act

HB 3033

The 88th Texas Legislature (2023) authorized the passage of HB 3033, which revised the Act by adding section 552.0031 to the Government Code, defining “business days” for purposes of the Act to mean any day other than a Saturday or Sunday, a national holiday, or a state holiday; and establishes that a school district board of trustees may designate up to ten additional days per calendar year as nonbusiness days.

Action recommended: Ten recommended nonbusiness days are listed in Consent Agenda for adoption through resolution in 2025, as well as acknowledged state and federal holidays.
