The spring and summer of 2018 have been busy for the human resources department and District 97 administrators. Due to Board approval of additional staff, enrollment increases at certain grade levels, and multiple (28) resignations, we have hired sixty-five new staff to date and are currently working on filling fifteen more positions. Of the sixty-five new hires, fifty-five are part of the teaching staff (OPTA members). Based on recent resignations, we have two classroom teaching positions and two assistant principal positions to fill. We expect to hire for the four unfilled positions by the time this report is presented to the Board.

The Board has asked for a report on the demographics of our new teaching (OPTA) staff. The data presented in this report includes new staff hired as of Thursday, August 9th at noon of the work day. The data presented in this report does not include administrators or support staff.
