RESOLUTION PLACING NICHOLAS JACOBS ON UNREQUESTED LEAVE OF ABSENCE

WHEREAS, no written request of any kind was received by the school board or superintendent of schools from Nicholas Jacobs for a hearing as of April 19, 2017, and

WHEREAS, said failure to make written request for a hearing within fourteen days after receipt of notice of proposed placement on unrequested leave constitutes acquiescence by Nicholas Jacobs to his placement on unrequested leave.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the School Board of Independent School District No. 726 that Nicholas Jacobs be and hereby is placed on unrequested leave of absence as a teacher of Independent School District No. 726 on the grounds of Discontinuance of Position, Lack of Pupils and Financial Limitations effective at the end of the 2016-17 school year on June 30, 2017 pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Sec.122A.40, Subd. 11, without pay or fringe benefits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a notice of placement on unrequested leave, together with a copy of this resolution be forwarded to said teacher personally and that an affidavit of same be placed in his/her file, together with a copy of the notice and resolution.
