RE: Board Action: Installation of Playground at TJD

In accordance with Dixon Public Schools #170 Board of Education Policy 2:20 Powers and Duties of the Board of Education, the Board enters into contracts in accordance with applicable federal and State law, including using the public bidding procedure when required. In this situation, the District has engaged OMNIA purchasing partnership which holds state contracts. The utilization of their products and serves does not require a public bidding process.

Enclosed you will find the complete presentation of the of the playground to be constructed at Thomas J. Dempsey Therapeutic Day School. The playground was created in consultation with J. Huffman, S. Eddinger, and K. Schultz. This project will be funded by the IDEA grant. The cost outlined on page #9 as a total of \$229,886.59. Please remember that installations of playground equipment at schools and park districts is a specialty field. This is not the type of system that can be installed by any contractor or our maintenance team.

The quote includes installation and all warranties for materials and labor. Also note the project includes the installation of the "Poured in Place Rubber Safety Surfacing". This is a high-quality product under the structure that eliminates the need for mulch and is significantly safer and more forgiving during falls. It is our intent over time to have these surfaces installed at all of our playground facilities.

It is the recommendation of District Administration to approve the purchase and construction of the TJD playground as presented.

- PRICING: Due to fluctuating economic conditions, pricing is valid for 30 days and is subject to change. Please request
  updated pricing if your quote is older than 30 days before making a purchase.
- TERMS OF SALE: For equipment & material purchases, Net 30 days from date of invoice for governmental agencies and those with approved credit. All others, full payment for equipment, taxes and freight up front. Balance for services & materials due upon completion or as otherwise negotiated upon credit application review. Pre-payment may be required for equipment orders totaling less than \$5,000.
   Payment by VISA, MasterCard, or AMEX is accepted (If you elect to pay by credit card, GameTime charges a 2.50% processing fee that is assessed on the amount of your payment. This fee is shown as a separate line item and included in the total amount charged to your credit card. You have the option to pay by check, ACH or Wire without any additional fees.). - SHIPMENT: Standard Lead time is 6-8 weeks (some Items may take longer) after receipt and acceptance of purchase order, credit
  application, color selections and approved drawings or submittals.
- PACKAGING: All goods shall be packaged in accordance with acceptable commercial practices and marked to preclude confusion during unloading and handling.
- RECEIPT OF GOODS: Customer shall coordinate, receive, unload, inspect and provide written acceptance of shipment. Any damage to

  must be in unused and merchantable condition. GameTime reserves the right to deduct costs associated with restoring returned goods to
  merchantable condition. Uprights & custom products cannot be returned.
- TAXES: Sales tax is shown as a separate line item when included. A copy of your tax exemption certificate must be submitted at time of


