This Board Report is to let the school board know that during the 2025-2026 school year, a committee will be reviewing potential English Language Arts curriculum for grades 6-12. A committee made up of teachers, administrators, and specialists will meet in November 2025 to review five possible curriculums. Each curriculum is on the approved list from the Oregon Department of Education. The committee will review and rate these five options and narrow to two final curriculum to use with students in January and February. In March, the committee will select the final curriculum to propose to the school board for adoption Spring 2026. The approved curriculum will be purchased and used starting with the 2026-2027 school year.

**Provide history/background information on your proposal:**

In accordance with policy IIA-AR(1), this is the notification to the board that the adoption committee is meeting during the year to review curriculum to be adopted by the board at the May 2026 board meeting.

**List the advantages of your proposal:**

It has been 10+ years since we have adopted ELA curriculum for middle school and 15+ years since high school has received ELA curriculum. The current Literacy Grant that TRSD received requires us to adopt current research-based curriculum for grades 6-12.

**List possible disadvantages of your proposal:**

If the committee does not meet this year, they will not review materials and will be unable to recommend adoption by the board in May 2026. This will increase the workload for teachers and will not meet the requirements of the literacy grant.
