<b>Background:</b> A total of \$319,000 in Capital Projects Funds (Bonds 2017 Savings and Interest) is requested for School Safety related projects. These include \$85,000 for Special Services (AA and SD Classrooms) projects at various elementary schools, \$110,000 to modify student restrooms at our secondary schools, \$100,000 for tasers for School Liaison Officers (SLOs) and \$24,000 to partially fund League City's purchase of a mini-ambulance for use at both stadiums. An additional \$647,000 in Capital Projects Funds (Bonds 2017 Savings and Interest) is requested for a detailed facility assessment and facility condition index database to support long-range facilities planning and preventative maintenance.
